

## PROFESSIONAL IN PRACTICE

### CLAIMING A PIP REQUIREMENT EXAMPLE

**“I have chosen this PiP requirement** because I can evidence that the training has impacted on my practice and meets the criteria of this requirement. **This requirement is most relevant to my practice** because I am in training and advisory role and therefore it is important that I use guidance, legislation, up to date research and methods of practice to inform my individual practice. **Through application of knowledge and skills** I acquired through the training, **I have demonstrated that I have** systematically and appropriately applied policy, guidance and legislation. **An example of this is in the** adaptation and development of training materials and resources for designated teachers following on from new guidance in “Co-operating to safeguard children and young people in Northern Ireland”. **I have also used different learning methods to develop my knowledge and improve my skills** this had included formal training, individual research, group work, reading and practical application of assessment frameworks using case studies. **In this way I have met the requirement and have demonstrated** “methods of practice that include a range of skills”. **Through subsequent use of supervision and discussion with my line manager and colleagues I have critically reflected on my practice** and made appropriated changes to my knowledge skills and values which have been evidenced in my reflection on each individual training session. **This training has had an impact on my knowledge skills and values** and I have used supervision to discuss this impact which, on a general level, has usually meant a change to advice given, training or provision of support resources to schools. On a more personal level the impact has been made to my values as the training has given me the resources and provided an opportunity to reflect on my current thinking. I have demonstrated the impact of the learning in each of the training session logs.”
